## Report on Orientation Programme of MBA 2023-2025

School of Management (formerly School of Petroleum Management), Pandit Deendayal Energy University (PDEU) organized an orientation program for its MBA entrants. The orientation was organized for one week starting from 20<sup>th</sup> June 2023.
