Subject: Note for BoS by Circulation

Dear BoS Members,

Greetings from SPM, PDPUI!

In April / May 2017 we had course review meeting, wherein we sought inputs from alumni and our recruiters.

Please find below the note related to proposed changes in MBA course curriculum at SPM.

1. Introduce new course on "Renewable Energy Project Management" (1.5 Credits) as an elective in second year for E & I Specialization.
2. A course entitled Business Analytics (1.5 Credits) to be introduced as an elective in second year for E & I as well as General Management Specialization. This course shall replace the existing 1.5 Credit Operations Analytics course in both the specializations.
3. Credits for MIS course to be reduced to 1.5 from 3.0 in E&I as well as General Management specializations. This was done looking into the fact that most of the students come with basic knowledge of Information Systems (IS) and hence duplication needs to be avoided. Moreover many contemporary aspects are also covered in IS elective courses.
4. A student has to complete minimum 24.0 credits {out of total 30 credits to be earned from elective courses; the criterion of earning 30.0 credits in elective courses remain unchanged} in Energy & Infrastructure elective courses. This is 3.0 credits more than the earlier requirement of minimum 21.0 credits. This has been done keeping the requirement of an intensive knowledge and skill set in E&I domain. Rest 6.0 credits may be earned from other functional/general courses or a student can take all 30.0 credits within E & I courses. Some of the E & I Discipline Electives are also sub-classified under Marketing/Finance/HR/Operations function Electives. Rest of the credits can be earned from remaining E & I courses and / or other functional area electives. To get functional sub-specialization within E & I domain minimum 9.0 credits in respective functional area (i.e. Marketing/Finance/Operations/H.R) are needed.

We look forward to your consideration for the above changes.
